Scramble Rules of Play

1. Four players per team, with the team captain designated by the organizing committee. The team captain is responsible for:
 - ◆ Proper team teeing position on each hole, and ensuring that the rules of play are followed.
 - ◆ Keeping the team score, and turning the signed score card in at the conclusion of the round to the course marshal.
 - ◆ Advising team members of hole competitions (longest drive, Beat the GM, etc.).
2. During the round each player must use three tee shots.
3. Each team member will drive from either the silver (men) or red (ladies, juniors) tee area. The best drive will be selected by mutual agreement, or by the team captain, and all other team members will pick up their balls and move to this selected position. Team members will place their ball within 12" of that position, no nearer the hole, and hit their shots. This procedure will continue until the team has reached the green. NOTE: All players may use "preferred lies".
4. On the green, a mark will be placed immediately adjacent to the ball being played and the other balls are to be placed in this spot occupied by the original ball. This procedure will continue until the team has holed out.
5. Player whose ball is being used for play must shoot/putt first.
6. In the event a ball must be played from a sand trap, the area may be raked between shots; however, the original lie must be simulated and the ball placed.
7. Tie breaker. In the event of a tie for the team prizes (top three teams and last place), a draw will be held at the dinner.

Weather

Rain, wind, or shine, the golf tournament will go on. If the course is closed due to severe inclement weather (this decision will be made by the golf course management at 10:00 a.m.), all players will receive a free pass to the Royal Tyrrell Museum. The silent auction, dinner, and prize presentations will still proceed at 3:30 p.m. In case the golf portion of the tournament is cancelled all players may request a refund of \$150, or utilize it as a charitable donation with tax receipt.

Last-Ditch Practice

On the morning of the tournament the driving range is complimentary. Buckets of balls will be available right at the driving range.

Pre-Tournament Chipping and "Putt for a Car" Contests

Between 8:15 - 9:30 a.m., participants are invited to take part in a complimentary chipping contest at the clubhouse practice green (by the #1 tee box). As well, a 10 ft. - 20 ft. - 30 ft. putting contest will take place at 9:40 a.m. - three lucky participants will have their name drawn for a chance to win a 2010 JEEP Compass.

Contests

During the tournament, players passing the practice green can take part in a putting contest. Entry fee is \$5 each. All contest participants will receive a sleeve of golf balls - successful participants will also have their name entered in a draw to win a JVC Stereo Systems.

On the #16 tee box (a 197 yd. Par 3 hole), you can wager (up to \$50) Uncle Zeke that you will be closer on the green than him. To give you an even greater advantage, you can also choose the club that Uncle Zeke will have to use.

On Hole #8, players can only play with one club - they must declare the club prior to anyone in their group teeing off. That club must be used for every shot (including putts) - no sharing of clubs amongst players.

On Hole #14, no driving the green is allowed on the tee-shot.

Course Marshal

David Daly will be the course marshal, and will use "positive reinforcements" to keep play flowing.
